



Electrical and Electronic Units Act – ElektroG dated 16th March, 2005 (RoHS directive 2002/95/EC and WEEE directive 2002/96/EC)

Dear Sir or Madam,

Following a systematic product analysis, we can make the following statement regarding our current delivery range (catalogue revision January 2006):

- The products of our „Pipe connecting systems“ delivery range conform with RoHS.
- The products of our „BLOCAN® Profile systems“ delivery range conform with RoHS.
- The products of our „Actuator systems“ delivery range conform RoHS.
- With a few exceptions, the products of our „Linear components“ delivery range conform with RoHS.

For individual partial components of these ranges we are unfortunately unable to obtain confirmation of RoHS conformity from the manufacturers concerned. Their reasoning is based on the technical feasibility in older assembly groups and electronic components that are currently not available in the market.

For new development we will obviously only use RoHS conforming components and assure you that we are continuously endeavoring to also replace the remaining non-conforming components.

In the event of deviations from the standard range, a special agreement will be reached with the customers as necessary.

The above information is given to the best of our knowledge.
